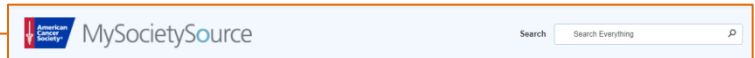

A driving force for My Society Source is ease in finding what you need. The header includes a powerful search tool for past articles on various topics.



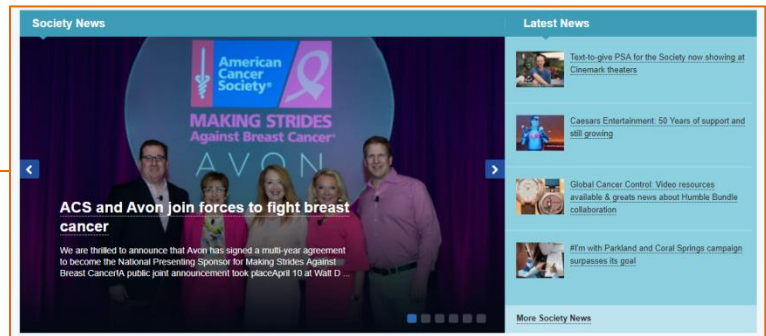
Global Navigation

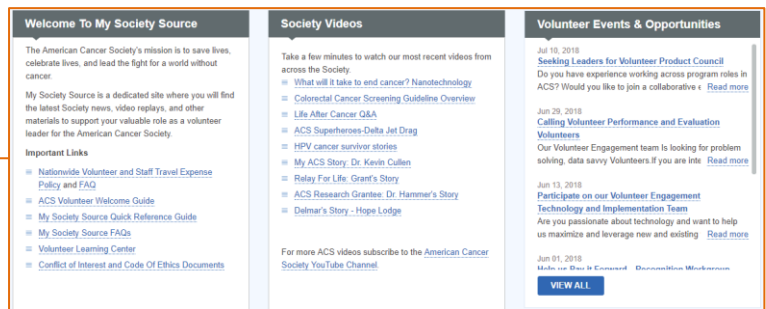

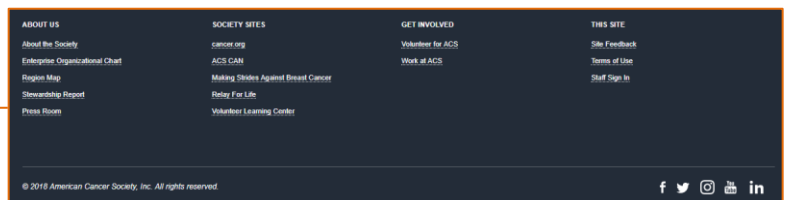

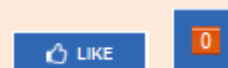

Search

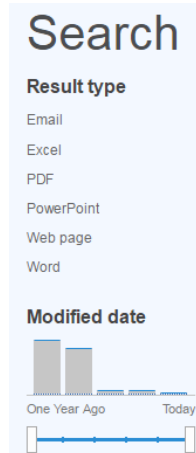
Enter keywords and operators (AND, OR, *, "") to describe to the Search the resource(s) you are interested in finding.

Operators:

- AND – to narrow search results to only those that include each keyword
- OR – to expand the search to include more keywords
- * - the asterisk can be used as a wildcard to return variations of the keyword or in place of letters if unsure of the keyword spelling.
- "" – to find an exact phrase

Refine Search Results



On the Search results screen, the options to further refine the search appear above the results and in the left side navigation.

The left side navigation on the Search results screen contains filters including:

- **Result type** – click the link for which type of resource to include in the results
- **Modified date** – click the timeline to identify the range of time to include

Search will look for resources both on My Society Source and within your Board sites based on the keyword entered.
