- ◆ When transacting with ACS staff for small dollar transactions (\$500 or less), one-time, and/or emergency purchases, the American Cancer Society encourages our staff to pay via their ACS credit card (P-Card).

If your company is not set up to transact via credit card, we have provided a list of mobile credit card reader companies for your consideration. The set-up process is relatively fast and inexpensive and in many cases the credit card reader is free.

To work more efficiently and potentially expand your business to new customers also seeking credit card options, we encourage you to consider the use of a credit card reader.
